## Summer Academics

June 18<sup>th</sup> – August 3<sup>rd</sup> (7 Weeks)

Every Morning (Except Wednesday)

from 8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

The Summer Enrichment Program provides **academic reinforcement** during the long summer months; idle weeks can be turned into productive weeks.

Seven weeks of instruction are provided in Math, Grammar, Bible, Vocabulary, Reading (or Literature), Science, History, and Geography.

Summer Enrichment is a four day program: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, from 8:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. each day. This schedule is coordinated with the All Day Program to provide a full-day and full-week program, if desired.

An **E.L.L. class** will be offered for non-and-limited English speaking campers to enhance speaking, reading, and writing English.

Summer Enrichment tuition **covers all supplies, books, and before school care from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m.** The registration fee covers office records, student accident insurance, emergency preparedness supplies, and one camp t-shirt. Registration fees are **non-refundable**.



## All Day Program

June 12<sup>th</sup> – August 10<sup>th</sup>

Monday – Friday

From 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Activities are scheduled after academics, four afternoons (12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.) and one full day (Wednesday) from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. All off-campus activities are carefully supervised with one counselor for every eight or ten children. Our school provides bus transportation.

The All Day Program **includes our Summer Academics** and all activities on and off campus at a reduced price. Tuition **covers transportation, supplies, entrance fees, sports, and before & after school care** from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**Hot lunches** will be served on a daily basis for **\$5.00** (unless otherwise designated). **All lunches must be paid in cash or check.** On **Thursdays**, we encourage all campers to participate in our special **“Theme Lunch”**.

For Water Wars and Beach Days, wear your swimsuit **under your clothing** and bring a towel. Flip Flops are only allowed on water activity days. Wear socks for skating and bowling.

**Camp Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.**

**Camp shirt must be worn every Wednesday.**

**Extra t-shirts are available for \$10.00**

## SUMMER CAMP POLICIES 2012

### **Camp Hours:**

Monday – Friday  
7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

### **Academics Hours:**

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday  
8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

### **Registration:**

An \$80.00 registration fee is *non-refundable* and covers one camp t-shirt, office records, and student accident insurance (summer camp medical insurance is intended to supplement family policies). An additional \$20.00 deposit, per week, is due upon registration for each week your child is registered to attend. Deposits are non-refundable and may not be applied toward any other week. This deposit secures your child a space in the camp for each week registered. A space in the camp cannot be guaranteed if this deposit is not made.

### **Academic Fees (Half Day Program):**

Weekly fees are \$130.00 and are due each Friday (the week prior) or by Monday morning of that week's classes. A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged if weekly fees are not paid by the close of camp each Monday (6:00 p.m.). **Sorry, no refunds or credits.**

There is a *late pick-up charge* of \$8.00 for any portion of 15 minutes per camper not picked up by 11:45 a.m. If it becomes necessary to take the camper on that day's activity, the fee for that day's activity will be charged and is payable at the time of pick-up.

### **Camp Fees (Full Day Program):**

Weekly camp fees for 1st - 9th are \$210.00 for the first child and \$200.00 for any additional children. The child discount only applies to intermediate families. Fees are due each Friday (the week prior) or by Monday morning for that week's activities. Campers will not be allowed to participate in camp or activities if fees are not paid. A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged if weekly fees are not paid by the close of camp each Monday (6:00 p.m.). **Sorry, no refunds or credits.**

There is a *late pick-up charge* of \$8.00 for any portion of 15 minutes per camper not picked up by 6:00 p.m. Payment is due at the time of pick-up.

### **Returned Checks:**

A \$35.00 fee will be charged for checks returned by the bank for any reason. Payment by cash or money order may also be required if your check is returned.

### **Lunches & Snack Cards:**

All campers need to bring money to purchase lunch on all trips unless otherwise specified. There may be occasions when campers need to bring a sack lunch. We offer a hot lunch program on certain days of the week, or campers may bring a sack lunch from home. Snack cards may be purchased for our Eagle's Nest which offers afternoon snacks for campers.

**Camp T-Shirts:**

Each camper will be issued one camp t-shirt as a part of their registration. CAMP T-SHIRTS MUST BE WORN ON ALL WEDNESDAY FIELD TRIPS. Campers will not be able to attend the field trip if they fail to wear a camp t-shirt. Sorry, NO EXCEPTIONS! Extra t-shirts are available for purchase for \$10. Any child who arrives on Wednesday without a camp t-shirt will be given a new one and charged \$10 which is payable at the time of pick up.

**Amusement Park Trips:**

We reserve the right to exclude students who are not willing to participate or who do not want to get on the rides.

**Dress Code:**

Clean, neat, modest and appropriate. Clothing should be appropriately functional for activities in which the students will attend. Girls must wear a one-piece swimsuit or a t-shirt covering any two-piece swimsuit. No crop tops, no spaghetti straps, no low cut tops, and midriffs must be covered. **NO SANDALS OR OPEN-TOED SHOES WILL BE ALLOWED.** Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are only permitted for swim/beach/water activity days. Campers will not be allowed to participate in camp activities if they are not wearing appropriate shoes. The camp's administration will be the final judge of what is appropriate.

**Personal Items:**

Campers are responsible for any personal items brought to summer camp. Backpacks are not allowed on field trips, however, fanny packs are allowed. Campers are encouraged to bring a water bottle from home. The camp will not be responsible for any lost or broken items. No electronic toys, games, cell phones, MP3 players, etc., will be permitted without camp approval. Lockers are available and recommended for grades 6th - 9th; however, there is a \$5.00 deposit for all locks and is refundable at the end of camp. The school will not be responsible for lost backpacks.

**Spending Money:**

Summer Camp staff is not responsible for money lost on campus or on field trips. Help is given to 1st - 5th grade campers with their spending money on field trips.

**Discipline Statement:**

It is our desire to maintain an atmosphere where your child will have the best time, in the safest environment possible. Campers are, at all times, expected to respect the authority of their counselors and other summer camp staff. Obedience, wholesome speech, honesty and respect for private property and the rights of others is essential. If a camper's behavior is not acceptable, disciplinary measures will be taken. In persistent cases or extreme behavior (i.e., fighting, swearing, theft) the camper will be asked to leave the camp for the day. Any such behavior displayed on campus or while on a field trip can result in suspension from summer camp. A copy of the "discipline form" with explanation of the unfavorable behavior will be given to the campers' parent/guardian when he/she is picked up from camp. If a camper is written up three times or more for a serious offense or extreme behavior, they also can be excluded from camp.
